Work as a local Councillor

Councillors have identified the work undertaken on behalf of local constituents. Including any major initiatives or special projects they have been associated with on behalf of CCC, which have a direct impact on local constituents.

Teifi ward has an urban and rural character, including the river Teifi that flows through the ward. Deprivation is an unwelcome feature, calling for the need to focus on projects and activities that attract funding and support for those members of our community that suffer hardship – be they children and young people, families or the elderly.

During the past 2 years the challenges faced by residents have been exacerbated as the Covid-19/ Lockdown period presented obstacles that were previously unknown. Serious issues have also faced our shops and small businesses, necessitating a strong focus on ensuring that they receive every financial and moral support possible.

Flooding continues to threaten residents and businesses adjacent to the river Teifi and a strong network of stakeholders ensures advice, cooperation and assistance when there is risk due to high tides and/or storms.
