Scheme

SCHEME MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EDUCATION AND SCIENCE UNDER SECTION 18  
OF THE CHARITIES ACT 1960

Application of Scheme

1. This Scheme applies to the benefaction for educational purposes consisting of the trust property now representing the endowment referable to the Gift of the Blaendyffryn Estate (including the invested sale proceeds realised by the sale authorised and effected in 1964 of the former Mansion House of the said Estate called Blaendyffryn Hall), in the Parish of Orllwyn Teifi, in the Administrative County of Cardigan, founded by a Deed of Gift executed by Mrs Lilian Cimara Doughty - Wylie, OBE, on 11th December 1948, and whereof at the date of this Scheme the Cardiganshire County Council (being the Local Education Authority and hereinafter in this Scheme called "the Council") is the Trustee.

Variation of Trusts, Administration and Title

2. The trusts declared by the said Deed of Gift dated 11th December 1948, in so far as by the effect of the Charitable Trusts (Validation) Act 1954 they are now applicable to the above-mentioned trust property and proceeds of sale, are hereby varied so that the said endowment (including the particulars specified in the Schedule to this Scheme) shall be administered by the Council in conformity with the provisions of this Scheme under the name of THE COE MEMORIAL EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION (hereinafter in this Scheme called "the Foundation").

Delegation

3. The Council may, if they think fit, with or without restrictions or conditions, delegate their powers under this Scheme to their Education Committee or to a body of persons constituted in such manner as the Council shall from time to time determine.

Councillors etc., not to be financially interested in the Foundation

4. Except in special circumstances, with the approval in writing of the Secretary of State for Education and Science (hereinafter in this Scheme called

"the Secretary of State"), no member of the Council or of their Education Committee or of a body to whom powers are delegated under this Scheme shall take or hold any interest in any property belonging to the Foundation otherwise than as a trustee for the purposes thereof, or receive any remuneration or be interested in the supply of work or goods at the cost of the Foundation.

#### Application of Income

5. (1) After payment of any expenses of administration, the net yearly income of the Foundation shall be applied by the Council for the benefit of beneficiaries in one or more of the following ways:-

(a) In the award to beneficiaries of scholarships, maintenance allowances, or grants tenable at any school, university, university college, college of education or other place of learning approved by the Council;

(b) In providing financial assistance, outfits, clothing, instruments, tools or books to help beneficiaries on leaving school, a university or other educational establishment, to prepare for, or to enter a profession, trade or calling;

(c) In awarding bursaries or maintenance allowances to enable beneficiaries to travel, whether in this country or abroad, to pursue their education;

(d) In providing financial assistance to enable beneficiaries to study music or other arts; or

(e) In otherwise promoting the education (including social and physical training) of beneficiaries:

Provided that awards consisting of the payment or part payment of fees shall be called "Coe Scholarships" and awards for purposes of educational travel shall be called "Coe Bursaries", and that awards of benefits of other kinds shall be suitably associated with the names of the late Mr. and Mrs. Harry Herbert Coe, formerly of Blaendyffryn Hall, Cardiganshire, in such manner as the Council may deem appropriate.

(2) Within the limits prescribed by this clause the Council shall have full power to make rules for the award of scholarships, bursaries, maintenance allowances, grants, or other benefits, including rules as to the value and period of tenure of the awards and the qualifications and method of ascertainment and selection, of beneficiaries.

(3) In this clause the expression "beneficiaries" means persons of either sex resident in the Administrative County of Cardigan who have not attained the age of 25 years, who are, or have for not less than two years at any time been, in attendance as registered pupils at a maintained Secondary School or as enrolled students at a maintained establishment of further education in the said County, and who, in the opinion of the Council, are in need of financial assistance.

#### Surplus Income

6. (1) Any income of the Foundation remaining unapplied in any year may be retained by the Council for application in the following year in the manner and to the objects above prescribed.

(2) Subject thereto, any sum of cash at any time belonging to the Foundation and not needed as a balance for working purposes shall, unless otherwise directed by the Secretary of State, be invested in trust for the Foundation.

#### General Power to make Rules

7. Within the limits prescribed by this Scheme, the Council shall have full power to make rules for the management of the Foundation.

#### Accounts

8. The Council shall provide and keep books of account referable to the income and expenditure of the Foundation, and proper accounts in relation thereto shall in each year be made out and certified in such form as the Secretary of State may require.

#### Management of Property

9. The Council shall let and otherwise manage any real property belonging to or held in trust for the Foundation and not occupied for the purposes thereof according to the general law applicable to the management of property by Trustees of charitable foundations.

#### Repairs and Insurance

10. The Council shall keep in repair and insure against fire any occupied buildings belonging to the Foundation not required to be kept in repair and insured by the lessees or tenants thereof.

#### Questions under Scheme

11. If any question arises as to the construction of this Scheme or as to the regularity or the validity of any acts done or about to be done thereunder, it shall be determined by the Secretary of State, upon such application made to her for the purpose as she thinks sufficient, and such determination shall be binding on the Council and all persons claiming under the trusts of this Scheme.

#### Interpretation

12. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Date of Scheme

13. The date of this Scheme shall be the day on which it is established by an Order of the Secretary of State.
